A.B. 401 / BDR 43 - 914

City/County: **Churchill County**

Comment: BDR 43-914 would have a positive fiscal impact to Churchill County, by creating additional revenue. This bill would impose an additional fee on owners of a clean vehicle (\$336) or a hybrid fuel vehicle (\$168) at the time of registration with the DMV. Of the money received by the department, half would go to the county for the construction, maintenance and repair of highways in that county, and the other half to the State Highway fund for use on state highways located in that county. Churchill County and other local government depend upon gas tax revenue to fund our Road Department and provide for the necessary financial resources to maintain, repair, and construct road infrastructure. Electric or hybrid vehicles requiring little to no fuel therefore provide little to no gas tax revenues, but still utilize county and state roads and highways in the same manner as those vehicles requiring fuel. Passage of this bill would create a positive fiscal impact for Churchill County, and would aid in generating revenues that may be used to maintain and construct roads.
