Comment: Because passing a civics exam would be a graduation requirement, students that do not pass the exam will need some sort of intervention in order to pass and graduate. Government is typically not provided to students until their final year of high school so it would be beneficial to provide a pretest the year prior. The District operates under a 4 day school week so Fridays would be available for remediation. If the District assumes that 20% of high school seniors do not pass the civics exam the first time, then approximately 50 students would require additional services. For the purpose of this estimate, the District has assumed one additional day for two teachers for the second half of the school year. Because this would be considered extra days, the wages would not be compensable under PERS.
