City/County: <b>Clark County</b> Approved by: David Dobrzynski, Asst Director of Finance Comment: This bill requires a notification of a parent or guardian under certain circumstances before a physician may perform an abortion on a pregnant minor or ward; providing expedited procedures for an agency which provides child welfare services to grant authorization for a proposed abortion without such notification; providing expedited procedures for the judicial review of the decision of an agency which provides child welfare services; making the files and records relating to certain abortions confidential. DFS would need to hire 2 supervisors and 10 Senior Family Services Specialists to conduct assessments required per this bill language. This bill would go outside the core scope of DFS because it would also include non-DFS cases that are considered under this bill. This bill also does not define who will be responsible for paying the costs of the abortions, should it be authorized without notification to the parent or legal guardian. It does not address who would be responsible for the costs of other related medical care (e.g. care due to complications, mental health care, prescriptions, etc.) resulting from the abortions. Additionally, there would also be personnel and administrative costs, including training and development of policies and procedures associated with this bill.
