Comment: Section 13 1 through 5 states that a person may petition the board to determine if the criminal history disqualifies that person from obtaining a license or registration. The initial determination may be made by staff and the boards Deputy Attorney General. If the determination results in the petitioner requesting a review by the board, subsection 5 states: "The governmental entity or regulatory body shall issue its determination within 90 days after the governmental entity or regulatory body receives the petition". As the board meets quarterly, depending on when the petition is received, the board may have to call a special meeting to review and act on the petition. Thus the cost for travel, per diem and staff is being calculated at one extra meeting per quarter. All cost to cover both scenarios, will be paid for by registration fees from our licensees not state funds. This will place an extra cost on our licensees, unless the cost is paid for by the petitioner.
