The Nevada Commission on Ethics does not regulate or oversee any of the professional occupations set forth in this bill, and it is not a governmental entity which certifies or licenses these natural persons. Instead, the Commission governs conflicts of interest of public officers and employees. Accordingly, this bill has no fiscal impact on the Commission.

Comment: BDR 54-930 makes changes to licensing requirements and other regulations on natural persons who engage in certain occupations within this State. Section 10 sets forth the policy concerning occupational regulations, including using the least restrictive regulation to protect consumers from harms that threaten public health and safety. Section 13 provides that a natural person with a criminal history may petition the responsible governmental entity or regulatory body, at any time, including before obtaining any required education or paying any fee, for a determination of whether the natural person's criminal history will disqualify the natural person from obtaining an occupational license, a specialty occupational license for medical reimbursement or certification to engage in a lawful occupation. Section 14 provides that, in the event of a conflict between this bill and certain existing occupational regulations within the Nevada Revised Statutes, the provisions of this act will control.

The Department currently has a Hearings Section that considers petitions from the public on issues related to regulations and procedures. Department procedural changes will be required with passage of this bill. Passage of this bill will not have a fiscal impact on the Department.

The Department of Public Safety (DPS), General Services Division (GSD) is unable to determine the fiscal impact at this time due to the complexity and multiple program areas within GSD this bill encompasses. There are several sections of this bill where GSD would require additional clarification to formulate the fiscal impact. One item that will need to be specified that is unclear to GSD staff is, if the intent of this bill is to obtain criminal history by submission of fingerprints to the Central Repository for forwarding to the FBI, if so then the FBI will need to review and approve the language pursuant to Public Law 92-544 as a condition of releasing its criminal history records. GSD requests to return to the Nevada Legislature's Interim Finance Committee in the 2017-2019 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
