BDR 20-400 expands various provisions relating to disclosure of confidential information. Sections 29-40 amend Chapter 481 of NRS to permit the use of an alternate address on driver's license, commercial driver's license, and standard identification card. The use of an alternate address is only allowed to certain State of Nevada criminal justice and court system employees and their spouse, domestic partner, or minor child. Those who request an alternate address must submit satisfactory proof to the Department of Motor Vehicle (DMV) to qualify.

All amendments made to this Bill remove all fiscal impact to the DMV and the proposed implementation date of 10/01/2017 can be met based on the amended language in this Bill.
