The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) had reviewed BDR 15-1219, which makes proposed revisions to NRS 193 related to the criminal penalty for certain crimes committed against first responders. The proposed statute revision states that a person who commits battery, assault, mayhem, robbery, murder, manslaughter, theft, larceny; or poisons or falsely imprisons a first responder, such as a police officer, a fire fighter, or an emergency medical technician may be subject to serve an additional sentence, in addition to the term of imprisonment required by statute for the crime. The sentence enhancement will be between one and twenty years and no longer than the sentence length imposed by statute. The NDOC has determined that there is a fiscal impact to future biennia.

The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) had reviewed BDR 15-1219, which makes proposed revisions to NRS 193 related to the criminal penalty for certain crimes committed against first responders. The proposed statute revision states that a person who commits battery, assault, mayhem, robbery, murder, manslaughter, theft, larceny; or poisons or falsely imprisons a first responder, such as a police officer, a fire fighter, or an emergency medical technician may be subject to serve an additional sentence, in addition to the term of imprisonment required by statute for the crime. The sentence enhancement will be between one and twenty years and no longer than the sentence length imposed by statute. The NDOC has determined that there is a fiscal impact to future biennia.

NRS 200.471 and 200.481 provide specific penalties for assault or battery on a public officer, a health care provider, or a taxi driver. Between July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012 and May 10, 2017, the Nevada Department of Corrections admitted 13 offenders in custody who were convicted of assaulting a public officer, battery on a police officer with or without a deadly weapon, and resisting a police officer with a deadly weapon. The commission of one of these types of crimes is typically a category B offense with a length of stay of 35.78 months. If the sentence length for these offenders is doubled, the length will be an average of 72 months. Should the pattern in admissions continue into the future, the NDOC will begin to feel the fiscal impact as of October of SFY 2021. Additional costs will amount to \$3,457.98 in SFY 2021 and \$14,385.41 in SFY 2022. The cost calculation is provided in Attachment A. Nevada law doesn't provide specific penalties for commission of robbery, larceny, poisoning, or false imprisonment of a public officer; thus, the impact of a sentence enhancement for these types of crimes cannot be determined.

For more serious crimes such as murder or mayhem, the sentences imposed by the court vary greatly among offense types, with many of them serving minimum terms of 2 years and maximum terms of 10, 15, or 20 years; life in prison with possibility of parole; or life in prison without possibility of parole. Thus, it is not possible to derive an accurate projection of the impact of doubling the sentence length when the victim of murder or mayhem is a police officer, a fire fighter, or an emergency technician. However, existing cases involving the murder of a police officer have resulted in life sentences or death row sentences. For these types of cases, doubling the sentence length will have no impact.
