BDR 15-1219 section 1 provides that any person who willfully commits certain crimes because of the fact that the victim is a first responder be punished by imprisonment in the state prison for a minimum of not less than 1 year and a maximum term of not more than 20 years. Enactment of this bill as introduced would require staff of the General Services Division (GSD) to create 151 new Nevada Offense Codes (NOCs). Although this bill would have a major impact to workload, GSD has calculated the cumulative total of current active bills from the 2017 legislative session, to include this bill draft and has determined that it would not necessitate additional staffing.
