This bill would require counties to establish certain polling locations at which a person could register to vote on Election Day and then cast a ballot (i.e., same-day registration). This would require election officials to search the Statewide Voter Registration List (SVRL) to determine if a person is registered elsewhere in the state and perform the necessary Help America Vote Act (HAVA) validations with the Department of Motor Vehicles and the Social Security Administration. All this must be done onsite at the same-day registration polling location and in real-time.

In order to ensure the person has not already cast a ballot elsewhere in the state, local election officials would have to update voter history in real-time. The SVRL would need to be enhanced to receive and display voter history in real-time. It is anticipated that the SVRL enhancements would cost \$50,0000 and the associated hardware would cost another \$50,000, for a total cost of \$100,000.

Please note that these cost estimates are only for the Secretary of State's office. The counties would likely have additional costs to implement same-day registration.
