BDR 14-138 (AB26) amends AB47 from the 2015 Legislative Session to allow employment screening services to participate on behalf of other screening services and removes the requirement for employers to be based in Nevada. The General Services Division (GSD) - Criminal History Repository (CHR) is a fee-funded agency based upon the services it provides. If approved, CHR will have the ability to collect fees from out of state customers for name based background checks which would increase the division's overall revenue. At this time, if this bill is enacted, CHR does not have the ability to determine the actual fiscal impact until a caseload baseline is established.
