BDR 57-381 (AB15) section 3 makes a person who commits insurance fraud by knowingly and willfully causing a motor vehicle to strike another guilty of a category B felony. Enactment of this bill as introduced would require staff of the General Services Division (GSD) to create 3 new and modify 1 Nevada Offense Codes (NOCs). The impact cannot be determined until GSD calculates the cumulative total of all legislation from the 2017 session. GSD requests to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2017-2019 biennium should the cumulative workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
