The proposed legislation appears to align state law with the existing policy of the Board of Regents regarding the assessment of tuition charges for students whose parent, legal guardian, or spouse is a member of the Armed Forces of the United States and is or was (at the time of the student's enrollment) on active duty in Nevada or the Marine Corps Warfare Training Center (Pickle Meadow, CA). Therefore, these portions of the bill appear to have no fiscal impact on the Nevada System of Higher Education (NSHE) or its institutions.

The section pertaining to students receiving benefits under the Fry Scholarship may have a fiscal impact on NSHE institutions; however, it is difficult to calculate the fiscal impact. This scholarship is available to children and surviving spouses of Servicemembers who died in the line of duty while on active duty after September 10, 2001. It is not possible to predict the number of students who may be attending NSHE institutions with this educational benefit.
