Comment: This bill revises provisions relating to the surrender of a newborn child to a provider of emergency services and a transfer of identifying information of the parent(s) surrendering the newborn child(ren). There is no fiscal impact to the Department of Family Services (DFS). This BDR is for a change to an existing law. Under current law, referrals for these children are received by the DFS Intake (Hotline) unit. This process will not change with the proposed language modifications in this bill that are referring to the transfer of identifying information of the parent(s) surrendering the child(ren).
