Comment: Carson City has in excess of 10 exams each year. The approximate cost of an exam is \$600. This would equate to \$6,000 in reimbursements annually from the State.

Comment: BDR 15-387 allows for reimbursement up to \$10,000 to a county for costs associated with sexual assault kit forensic examinations. However, there may be negative fiscal impacts to Churchill County associated with the lab costs to catch-up on processing these kits. Churchill County currently contracts with Washoe for these services, and we may see the contracted amount increase. The fiscal impact is difficult to determine. Additionally, there is not an exception for sexual assault cases where the kit was taken but law enforcement has proven through investigation that the allegations are false. This is not an uncommon situation, and passage of this BDR would mandate sending these kits through a lab; thereby generating unnecessary labor and expense to the counties.

Comment: This bill will require LVMPD to submit a sexual assault forensic evidence kit (SAFE kit) to a forensic lab within 30 days and the forensic lab must test within 180 days. LVMPD would be required to report annually to the Legislative Counsel Bureau. County may be reimbursed in an amount equal to 10 forensic medical exams or \$10,000 (whichever is less) each fiscal year.

For LVMPD to comply with this bill, they will need to hire 7 additional staff at a cost of \$1,016,752 and additional consumables of \$506,030 for a total of \$1,522,782 cost. County contribution is approximately 60% to LVMPD.

This does not include the cost of processing the current backlog of Sexual Assault cases (approximately 7,500 kits in the State of Nevada).
