This would negatively impact the City's ability to determine where and how we provide utility service, and could place an unfair burden on municipal residents. Furthermore, it doesn't require County owned utilities to reciprocate. Based on this legislation, unincorporated counties could approve the most inefficient, unserviceable land use patterns and City residents would have to subsidize them because they can't charge disparate rates.
