The passage of AB 18, the Enhanced Nurse Licensure Compact, may affect the revenue to the Nevada State Board of Nursing. On one hand, nurses currently licensed in Nevada, who reside in another Compact state, may not renew their Nevada nursing license. These application or renewal fees of \$100 every two years would be lost. If all of the licensed Nevada nurses with out of state addresses fail to renew, this may result in lost revenue of upwards of \$180,000 per year. On the other hand, this loss might be offset by the anticipated increase in Nevada licensees. And not all nurses with out of state addresses are or will be in Compact states. The Board of Nursing believes that any potential fiscal impact will be absorbed by the Board's current budget and does not anticipate that any increase in licensing fees would be necessary.
