Decision unit E350 in the Governor's Recommended budget adds approximately \$1.04 million in state fiscal year 2018 and \$1.34 million in state fiscal year 2019 to open two day reporting centers in Nevada. This includes eight new positions to help supervise offenders in the day reporting centers.
