No Fiscal Impact. BDR 49-176 adds a definition for the accreditation of governmental agencies, addresses other definitions and clarifies an abused licensing exemption. Most government agencies already have their staff obtain a Restricted Use Pesticide (RUP) certification from the Department of Agriculture. This BDR proposes to combine a General Use and RUP certificate under one "accreditation" for government agencies. While the accreditation technically creates a new fee, that cost will be offset by eliminating the need for them to obtain the separate RUP certificate. The other issues addressed in the BDR do not change existing fees, hence the BDR does not have fiscal impact.
