BDR 15-509 (SB109) prohibits an officer or employee of the state or political subdivision thereof or any other person from requiring another person to undergo the implantation of a microchip or other permanent identification marker. Enactment of this bill as introduced would require staff of the General Services Division (GSD) to create 4 new sub-types and create 4 new Nevada Offense Codes (NOCs). The impact cannot be determined until GSD calculates the cumulative total of all legislation from the 2017 session. GSD requests to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2017-2019 biennium should the cumulative workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
