This bill provides for the registration of psychological assistants, psychological interns and psychological trainees. The bill also requires that any activity or service performed by a psychological assistant, psychological intern, or psychological trainee must be performed under the supervision of a psychologist in accordance with regulations adopted by the Board of Psychological Examiners. The projected impact which represents the cost of licensed psychologists supervision required for psychological assistants, interns, and trainees for fiscal year 2017-18 and fiscal year 2018-19 is \$171,593 per year or \$343,186 for the 2017-2019 biennium. The projected fiscal impact on future biennia is \$343,186.
