Comment: BDR 27-430 amends Chapter 333 of the Nevada Revised Statutes to provide for the disposition of rebates for purchases made with procurement cards. The amendment also further defines that after deducting administrative costs: (1) 50 percent of any such rebate is deposited into the Account to Stabilize the Operation of the State Government, also known as the Rainy Day Fund; and (2) the other 50 percent is given to the state agency that made the purchase.

Procurement cards are not frequently utilized for Department of Motor Vehicles' purchases and rebates that occur from procurement card purchases would be handled using the existing work program process.
