The Governor's Finance Office believes that there will be a fiscal impact from the regulation promulgation process, which may be lengthy due to the bill's requirement to establish performance incentives for energy savings. Moreover, there may be additional staff work to analyze and monitor the energy efficiency plans submitted by electric utilities, including additional utility cost tests. However, the Governor's Finance Office does not have sufficient information to calculate a cost for the additional staff time or the rulemaking process based upon the information it has.
