BDR 40-802 Section 1 requires the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to accept proof of liability insurance that is designed, designated, or includes an endorsement specifically for classic or antique vehicles for all license plates issued pursuant to NRS 482.3814 or 482.3816 including "Classic Rod" or "Classic Vehicle" license plates. Programming of the DMV's computer system will be required to capture proof of classic or antique vehicle insurance designation.

Section 1 also requires the DMV to provide a form for verification of the odometer reading within 30 days preceding the registration or renewal of all specialty plates that have been issued pursuant to NRS 482.381, 482.3812, 482.3814, and 482.3816. This includes "Old Timer", "Street Rod", "Classic Rod", and "Classic Vehicle" license plates. The form must be completed by an approved inspector at an authorized inspection station or an authorized station. Regulation changes, allowing the approved inspector to verify the odometer reading, will be required.

The estimated programming to implement this BDR is 198 hours which can be completed with existing IT resources. The proposed implementation date of 01/01/2018 cannot be met because of the estimated programming hours needed to complete the requirements in addition to existing priorities and mandates.
