BDR 43-757 provides an update to the existing law that governs the use of cellular telephones or other handheld wireless communication devices while operating a motor vehicle. Current law allows the use of a cellular telephone or other handheld wireless communication device for voice communications as long as specific requirements are met. This BDR prohibits any operator of a motor vehicle under the age of 18 from using a cellular telephone or other handheld or mounted wireless communication device while operating a motor vehicle.

This will have no known fiscal impact on the Department of Motor Vehicles.
