This bill requires the State Plan for Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) to require veteran's benefits paid by the U.S. Department of Veteran's Affairs to be excluded from any calculation of income used to determine eligibility for benefits provided by the TANF program. This BDR has a fiscal impact, as it increases the current TANF population due to income from veteran's benefits no longer being considered when determining eligibility. However, currently the division cannot determine the impact, as data is not collected for applicants who receive veteran's benefits.
