DESCRIPTION OF FISCAL EFFECT

BDR/Bill/Amendment Number: BDR 33-515/SB244

Name of Agency: Division of Museums and History

Division/Department: Department of Tourism and Cultural Affairs

Date: March 22, 2017

The Board of Museums and History would require one additional board member in BA 2941 and the Division of Museums & History would require two new FTE professional positions in BA 2940 that would manage the multitude of new and expanded responsibilities set forth in BDR 33-515. An additional Grade 33, Curator 2 is required to meet the requirements under Section 3 and other sections of the Bill. Simply, determination of affiliation would require extensive research by a credentialed professional archeologist curator. While workloads by virtue of inclusion of the requirements of Section 6 of the Bill are speculative, additional professional staff [in addition to what is described herein] could be required if workload volumes exceed 50 new permit applications and other actions per annum. A FTE Program Officer 2 is sought to provide overall management of the notification, consultation and permitting sections of the Bill. In addition, the costs for an additional member of the Board of Museums & History, as identified in Section 8.2 are added. Not included are costs associated with enforcement or the confiscation of objects as the Division presently has no enforcement requirements and no experience with what would be necessary to accomplish requirements of Section 19.2 and other sections where enforcement is noted. Also, determining additional legal costs should legal challenges come forth pursuant to Section 35 are unable to be quantified. Section 21 of the Bill expands the provisions for enforcement of NRS 381.195 to 381.225 to include activities on private lands. It places the Division of State Parks, sheriffs in their respective counties, the Nevada Highway Patrol and other peace officers in the lead for enforcement. While such enforcement would require consultation with the Nevada State Museum in the matter of determining the veracity and extent of an antiquities permit, it is not possible today to predict how much time and effort would be involved in enforcing this provision as we have no experience with activities on private lands and no way to predict volume of such activity. However, the fiscal impact to the Division of State Parks in directly enforcing this section would be considerable.

Costs associated with SB244 encompass two separate budget accounts. NEBS attachments for both budget accounts are included as one attachment.
