BDR 43-606 Redo 1 section 6 authorizes the court to extend the order of a person required to install an ignition interlock if the court receives a report from the Department or the manufacturer of the device that the person has committed certain violations. Enactment of this bill draft request as introduced would require staff of the General Services Division (GSD) to modify 5 Nevada Offense Codes (NOCs). The impact cannot be determined until GSD calculates the cumulative total of all legislation from the 2017 session. GSD requests to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2017-2019 biennium should the cumulative workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
