Comment: BDR 38-817: This BDR appears to be very similar to BDR 38-858, as it also addresses contraceptives and hormone replacement therapy, placing extra minimum coverage requirements on insurance policies. Similarly to BDR 38-858, Churchill County anticipates an estimated a 1% - 2% increase in premiums per year to cover the additional requirements placed on insurance companies. This calculates to approximately \$17,000 to \$34,000 per year.
