BDR 23-1077 requires peace officers to be trained in the constitutional and lawful use of force as a condition of certification by the Peace Officers Standards and Training (POST) Commission. This bill becomes effective as of October 1, 2017.

This will not have an impact on the Department of Motor Vehicles. The Compliance Enforcement Division (CED) is the regulatory unit of the Department. CED is responsible for auditing, monitoring, inspecting and providing investigative services to internal/external entities related to DMV core programs. CED currently has thirty (30) sworn peace officers that conduct investigations and receive POST certification. CED anticipates designating one member of staff to receive "Train the Trainer" instruction on constitutional and lawful use of force methods through an external group whose courses of instruction are eligible for POST-certification. This Trainer will develop a training program for incorporation into the normal ongoing courses provided to CED officers. The Department anticipates that the cost for staff to receive this initial training will be less than \$1,500.00 and will be absorbed by the Division's budget.
