This bill provides that to the extent authorized by federal law, children under the age of 21 who are lawfully residing in the United States but have been here less than 5 years may enroll in Medicaid and the Children's Health Insurance Program. This population is currently not included in the Medicaid State Plan. As the bill is written, it would have a fiscal impact. Providing these services will result in increased total caseload of 89,808 member months in fiscal year 2017-18 and 2018-19. The increased costs for providing related services is expected to be \$19,180,663 in fiscal year 2017-18 and \$19,591,924 in fiscal year 2018-19. The fiscal impact on future biennia is \$38,772,587.
