Section 20 of this legislation would require Legislative Police Officers and the Legislative Counsel Bureau's Emergency Medical Technicians to complete annually a training course provided by the Division of Public and Behavioral Health concerning the rights granted to a person who holds a registry identification card or letter of approval issued pursuant to chapter 453A of NRS. Although the training may result in some rescheduling of work shifts and may result in some overtime costs for the Legislative Police Unit, the Legislative Counsel Bureau would be able comply with the requirements of the legislation without any additional resources.
