BDR 14-599 revises provisions relating to controlled substances. Section 14 deals with sealing of court records. The General Services Division would be impacted but the number of petitions filed and approved cannot be determined. Section 20 requires the Division of Public and Behavioral Health to provide training to all DPS employees. The type and amount of training is unknown. Various sections deal with saliva tests. The number of tests cannot be determined. Section 31 requires the Committee on Testing for Intoxication to certify a device to be accurate, reliable and capable of providing results from a person's saliva to determine the presence of marijuana. Until the Committee certifies a device/testing system, costs cannot be estimated.
