The agency has reviewed this BDR and determined there is not likely to be a fiscal impact with respect to Section 14. Sealing documents is a burden currently, so any more sealing orders just adds to that work. This change alone does not appear to call for additional staff unless there is an unanticipated increase in sealing orders. The training requirement in Section 20 captures "all peace officers" which would include NGCB Enforcement agents, but the burden to train appears to be on DHHS. As long as the training requirement is not more than a couple hours a year, it should not have a fiscal impact.
