BDR 14-559 proposes that the holder of a valid registry identification card that drives a vehicle has deemed to have given consent to a saliva test should the presence of marijuana be suspected. If the registry identification card holder fails to submit to the saliva test or the saliva test returns a positive result, then the law enforcement officer can request a blood test. There is no change to the DMV policy and procedures.
