The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) has reviewed BDR 15-505, which makes proposed revisions to NRS 205.060 related to persons convicted of a category B felony for burglary or another crime involving forcible entry or invasion of a dwelling. The number of convictions that will be accounted for will include those committed in the State of Nevada as well as in any other state. For offenses that did not involve a weapon or a firearm the penalty for a second offense will be increased from a minimum term of one 1 to 8 years and from a maximum term of 10 years to 20 years. If the offense involves the use of firearms or other deadly weapons, the minimum term will be increased from 2 years to 8 years and the maximum term from 15 to 20 years. The NDOC has determined that there is a fiscal impact to future biennia.

The Nevada Department of Corrections (NDOC) has reviewed BDR 15-505, which makes proposed revisions to NRS 205.060 related to persons convicted of a category B felony for burglary or another crime involving forcible entry or invasion of a dwelling. The number of convictions that will be accounted for will include those committed in the State of Nevada as well as in any other state. For offenses that did not involve a weapon or a firearm the penalty for a second offense will be increased from a minimum term of one 1 to 8 years and from a maximum term of 10 years to 20 years. If the offense involves the use of firearms or other deadly weapons, the minimum term will be increased from 2 years to 8 years and the maximum term from 15 to 20 years.

The NDOC has determined that there is a fiscal impact.

Should this bill pass, it will become effective July 1st, 2017. The amendatory provisions that count the number of prior convictions committed in this State or any other state will apply towards offenses committed prior to July 1st of this year and would result in an increased average length of stay for the average offender by 76.48 months. The NDOC has identified 66 offenders who were admitted between June of 2012 and March of 2017 for commission of burglary or invasion of a property multiple times. Of these 66 offenders, 3 were charged with using a firearm. These offenders were sentenced to an average minimum term of 24.5 months and an average maximum term of 77.1 months and have expected lengths of stay of 31.52 months. The proposed law will increase the minimum term to 96 months and the maximum term to 240 months with an average expected length of stay of 108 months. Thus, the sentence length will be 76.48 months longer for the average offender with at least 2 burglary or home invasion convictions in Nevada, when controlling for the possibility of convictions in another state.

Increased Penalty Cost Estimate for Existing Offenders

Exhibit 2 attached depicts the impact of the increased length of stay assumes the trend of 1.14 individuals per month + a growth rate of 1.40% will be committed to prison. The inmate driven cost is assumed at \$8.09 per day for Fiscal Year 2018 and \$8.19 per day for Fiscal Year 2019. With the assumptions of 1.40% growth rate and costs per day staying the same, the cost of extending the length of stay will add up to \$4,307.63 by the end of Fiscal Year 2020 rising to \$39,658.57 by the end of Fiscal Year 2021. The cumulative effect of the increased cost for length of stay amounts to \$1,619,724.71 from Fiscal Year 2022 to Fiscal Year 2030.

Exhibit 3 attached provides a detailed comparative analysis of the effect on inmate population and cost under current law and compared to the proposed revision. This analysis depicts the average monthly intake and release of existing inmates and costs from Fiscal Year 18 through Fiscal Year 2030.

Future Biennia Costs

As reflected in the attached Exhibit 2, Note: Annual projected growth rate is derived by JFA in February 2017. Daily costs per inmates are estimates based on the Governor Recommends Budget.

<u>Undeterminable</u>

The NDOC is unable to determine how many offenders will be convicted to the Nevada Department of Corrections in the future with prior convictions in other states for burglary or home invasion. The impact of incorporating these additional charges cannot be determined. It is assumed that the projected number of admissions would be larger, resulting in higher cumulative fiscal impacts.
