BDR 15-505 (AB333) section 1 provides that a person who is convicted of burglary and who has previously been twice convicted of burglary or another crime involving the forcible entry or invasion of a dwelling in this State or any other state is guilty of a category B felony. Enactment of this bill as introduced would require staff of the General Services Division (GSD) to create 4 new sub-types, create 15 new, and repeal 9 Nevada Offense Codes (NOCs). The impact cannot be determined until GSD calculates the cumulative total of all legislation from the 2017 session. GSD requests to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2017-2019 biennium should the cumulative workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
