BDR 15-406 (SB62) section 1 provides new language and penalty for a person who has been previously convicted of battery constituting domestic violence. Enactment of this bill as introduced would require staff of the General Services Division (GSD) to create 13 new and repeal 7 Nevada Offense Codes (NOCs). The impact cannot be determined until GSD calculates the cumulative total of all legislation from the 2017 session. GSD requests to return to the Interim Finance Committee in the 2017-2019 biennium should the cumulative workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
