This bill requires a Health Care Funding and Pricing Task Force to be impaneled to perform a comprehensive analysis of factors affecting the price of health care in this State versus others, including both privately funded health care and health care funded through Medicaid and the Children's Health Insurance Program. The bill requires establishing a basic health program pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 18051 and applying for a Waiver for State Innovation pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 18052, however neither of these two sections apply to Medicaid. The agency has reviewed the bill and determined that there is no fiscal impact.
