# Marsheilah Lyons, Committee Policy Analyst:

<u>Senate Bill 325 (1st Reprint)</u> requires the director of the Department of Health and Human Services to include in the State Plan for Medicaid and the Children's Health Insurance Program authorization for certain lawfully residing children under 19 years of age, who have resided in the United States for less than five years, to enroll in these programs. The measure allows for the reduction or elimination of certain benefits to these children in response to certain changes in federal law. This measure was heard in Committee on May 31, 2017. There are no amendments proposed for this bill, and it will be effective on July 1, 2017.
