SUMMARY—Prohibits any person from requiring <u>or authorizing</u> another person to undergo implantation of a microchip or other permanent identification marker <u>[-]</u> <u>under certain circumstances</u>.

AN ACT relating to crimes; prohibiting any person from requiring or authorizing another person to undergo implantation of a microchip or other permanent identification marker [+] under certain circumstances; providing a penalty; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:** 

This bill prohibits an officer or employee of this State or any political subdivision thereof or any other person from: (1) requiring another person to undergo the implantation of a microchip or other permanent identification marker of any kind or nature [+]; (2) establishing a program that authorizes a person to voluntarily elect to undergo the implantation of such a microchip or permanent identification marker; or (3) participating in a program established by another person, if the program authorizes a person to voluntarily elect to undergo the implantation of such a microchip or permanent identification marker. This bill also [provides that each day or part of a day during which a violation of such a provision is continued or repeated constitutes a separate offense.] defines "microchip" for the purposes of this bill.

# THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** Chapter 200 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

1. An officer or employee of this State or any political subdivision thereof or any other person shall not [require]:

(a) Require another person to undergo the implantation of a microchip or other permanent identification marker of any kind or nature [-];
(b) Establish a program that authorizes a person to voluntarily elect to

8	(a) "Microchip" means a device that is subcutaneously implanted in a person
9	and that is passively or actively capable of transmitting personal information to
10	another device using radio frequency technology.
11	(b) The term does not include a device that is subcutaneously implanted in a
12	person, if the device:
13	(1) Is incapable of passively or actively transmitting personal
14	information to another device using radio frequency technology and the device:
15	(I) Is used for the purpose of self-expression; or
16	(II) Is used in the diagnosis, monitoring, treatment or prevention of a
17	health condition; or
18	(2) Is capable of passively or actively transmitting personal information
19	to another device using radio frequency technology and the device:
20	(I) Is used in the diagnosis, monitoring, treatment or prevention of a
21	health condition; and
22	(II) Only transmits such information as is necessary to carry out the
23	diagnosis, monitoring, treatment or prevention of the health condition.
