AN ACT making [appropriations] an appropriation to the Interim Finance Committee for the unanticipated costs related to the implementation of Marsy's Law; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Interim Finance Committee the sum of \$10,000,000 for the unanticipated costs related to the implementation of Senate Joint Resolution No. 17 of the 78th Session of the Nevada Legislature, as approved and ratified by the people at the 2018 General Election, and commonly known as Marsy's Law. [the following sums:

For the Fiscal Year 2019 2020 \$5,000,000
For the Fiscal Year 2020 2021 \$5,000,000

Sec. 2. [The sums appropriated by section 1 of this act are available for either fiscal year.] Any remaining balance of [those sums] the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2021, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the appropriated is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after September 17, 2021, by either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before September 17, 2021.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective [on July 1, 2019.] upon passage and approval.
