THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Office of the Director of the Department of Corrections the sum of [\$1,479,223] \$5,169,127 for an unanticipated shortfall in utilities costs, inmate-driven costs_, [and] food costs [...] and medical costs. This appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 20 of chapter 396, Statutes of Nevada 2017, at page 2638.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
