SUMMARY—Directs the Legislative Commission to conduct an interim study concerning wildfires. (BDR R-509)

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ASSEMBLY CONCURRENT RESOLUTION—Directing the Legislative Commission to appoint a committee to conduct an interim study concerning wildfires.

1 WHEREAS, There is a growing threat of wildfires throughout the Western  
2 United States; and

3 WHEREAS, The State of Nevada has recently experienced several large and  
4 devastating wildfires; and

5 WHEREAS, A thorough legislative study of issues relating to wildfires is in the  
6 interest of the people of this State; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, THE SENATE  
8 CONCURRING, That the Legislative Commission is hereby directed to appoint as  
9 soon as practicable a committee to conduct an interim study concerning wildfires,  
10 as described herein, which is composed of:

11 1. Three members of the Senate, two of whom are appointed by the Majority  
12 Leader of the Senate and one of whom is appointed by the Minority Leader of the  
13 Senate; ~~and~~

14 2. Three members of the Assembly, two of whom are appointed by the  
15 Speaker of the Assembly and one of whom is appointed by the Minority Leader of  
16 the Assembly; and

17 3. Two members approved by the Legislative Commission, consisting of:  
18 (a) One member who is recommended by the Inter-Tribal Council of  
19 Nevada, Inc., or its successor organization, to represent tribal governments in  
20 Nevada; and

21 (b) One member who is recommended by the senior United States Senator  
22 for Nevada; and be it further

23 RESOLVED, That the Legislative Commission shall designate one of the  
24 members appointed to the committee who is a Legislator to serve as the Chair of  
25 the committee; and be it further

26 RESOLVED, That in performing the study, the committee shall consider, without  
27 limitation:

- 1 1. Methods of reducing wildfire fuels;
- 2 2. Issues related to early responses to wildfires; and
- 3 3. The economic impact of wildfires on the State and local communities; and
- 4 be it further

5 RESOLVED, That the committee should consult with and solicit input and  
6 recommendations from persons, entities and organizations with expertise in matters  
7 relevant to wildfires; and be it further

8 RESOLVED, That any recommended legislation proposed by the committee  
9 must be ~~approved~~;

10 1. Voted upon only by the members appointed to the committee who are  
11 Legislators; and

12 2. Approved by a majority of the members of the Senate and a majority of  
13 the members of the Assembly appointed to the committee; and be it further

14 RESOLVED, That the Legislative Commission submit a report of the results of  
15 the study and any recommendations for legislation to the Director of the Legislative  
16 Counsel Bureau for transmittal to the 81st Session of the Nevada Legislature; and  
17 be it further

18 RESOLVED, That this resolution becomes effective upon passage.
