AN ACT making ~~an appropriation~~ appropriations to the American Red Cross of Southern Nevada and the American Red Cross of Northern Nevada to pay certain costs relating to smoke alarms and home fire safety; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the American Red Cross of Southern Nevada the sum of ~~[\$300,000]~~ \$180,000 to pay for the costs of providing the following services to residents of Nevada:

- (a) Installation of smoke alarms;
- (b) Replacement of smoke alarm batteries;
- (c) Provision of preparedness education relating to home fire safety; and
- (d) Preparation of customized evacuation plans for home fires and related materials.

2. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the American Red Cross of Northern Nevada the sum of \$120,000 to pay for the costs of providing the following services to residents of Nevada:

- (a) Installation of smoke alarms;
- (b) Replacement of smoke alarm batteries;
- (c) Provision of preparedness education relating to home fire safety; and
- (d) Preparation of customized evacuation plans for home fires and related materials.

3. Upon acceptance of the money appropriated by subsection 1 ~~or 2~~ or 2, as applicable, the American Red Cross of Southern Nevada or the American Red Cross of Northern Nevada, as applicable, agrees to:

- (a) Prepare and transmit a report to the Interim Finance Committee on or before December 18, 2020, that describes each expenditure made from the money appropriated by subsection 1 or 2, as applicable, from the date on which the money was received by the American Red Cross of Southern Nevada or the

1 American Red Cross of Northern Nevada , as applicable, through December 1,
2 2020;

3 (b) Prepare and transmit a final report to the Interim Finance Committee on or
4 before September 17, 2021, that describes each expenditure made from the money
5 appropriated by subsection 1 or 2 , as applicable, from the date on which the
6 money was received by the American Red Cross of Southern Nevada or the
7 American Red Cross of Northern Nevada through June 30, 2021; and

8 (c) Upon request of the Legislative Commission, make available to the
9 Legislative Auditor any of the books, accounts, claims, reports, vouchers or other
10 records of information, confidential or otherwise, of the American Red Cross of
11 Southern Nevada or the American Red Cross of Northern Nevada, as
12 applicable, regardless of their form or location, that the Legislative Auditor deems
13 necessary to conduct an audit of the use of the money appropriated pursuant to
14 subsection 1 ~~4~~ or 2, as applicable.

15 ~~3~~ 4. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection 1 or 2
16 must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2021, by the entity to which
17 the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the appropriation is
18 granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated
19 money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after September 17, 2021, by
20 either the entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the
21 money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State
22 General Fund on or before September 17, 2021.

23 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2019.
