SUMMARY—Makes appropriations to the Nevada Gaming Control Board for modernization of the technology system and replacement of security system equipment ~~and~~ and extends the reversion date of a previous appropriation made to the Board for certain costs related to the Alpha Migration Project. (BDR S-1188)

AN ACT relating to the Nevada Gaming Control Board; making appropriations to the ~~Nevada Gaming Control~~ Board for the costs of modernization of the technology system and replacement of security system equipment; extending the reversion date of the appropriation made by the 79th Session of the Nevada Legislature to the Board for certain in-state travel costs related to the Alpha Migration Project; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to  
2 the Nevada Gaming Control Board the sum of \$7,218,698 for the Alpha Migration  
3 Project to modernize the COBOL-based computer system to a modern technology  
4 system.

5       2. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Nevada  
6 Gaming Control Board the sum of \$143,211 for the replacement of security system  
7 equipment in both the Carson City office and the Gaming lab.

8       **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by section 1 of  
9 this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2021, by the entity to  
10 which the appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the  
11 appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of  
12 the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after  
13 September 17, 2021, by either the entity to which the money was appropriated or

1 the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be  
2 reverted to the State General Fund on or before September 17, 2021.

3 Sec. 3. Section 2 of chapter 408, Statutes of Nevada 2017, at page 2740, is  
4 hereby amended to read as follows:

5 Sec. 2. 1. Any remaining balance of the ~~[appropriation]~~  
6 appropriation made by subsection 1 of section 1 of this act must not be  
7 committed for expenditure after June 30, 2019, by the entity to which the  
8 appropriation is made or any entity to which money from the appropriation  
9 is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the  
10 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose after  
11 September 20, 2019, by either the entity to which the money was  
12 appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently granted or  
13 transferred, and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before  
14 September 20, 2019.

15 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by subsection  
16 2 of section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June  
17 30, 2021, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or any entity to  
18 which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred  
19 in any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining  
20 must not be spent for any purpose after September 17, 2021, by either the  
21 entity to which the money was appropriated or the entity to which the  
22 money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be reverted to  
23 the State General Fund on or before September 17, 2021.
