AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the State Distributive School Account for an unanticipated increase in K-12 enrollment for the 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 school years; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the State Distributive School Account the sum of ~~(\$36,492,628)~~ \$8,246,261 for an unanticipated increase in K-12 enrollment for the 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 school years. This appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 3 of chapter 394, Statutes of Nevada 2017, at page 2592.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
