THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Division of Forestry of the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources the sum of [\$4,500,000] \$4,610,000 for the replacement of a helicopter.

There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Division of Forestry of the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources the sum of [\$2,234,850] \$2,527,420 for the replacement of emergency [response fire fighting and resource equipment] crew carriers for the Forestry Conservation Camps [for the Fiscal Year 2019 2020.]
