AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Nevada Supreme Court for a projected shortfall related to judicial selection processes; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Nevada Supreme Court the sum of [\$10,500] \$6,000 for a projected shortfall related to judicial selection processes. This appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 11 of chapter 396, Statutes of Nevada 2017, at page 2635.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
