AN ACT relating to social workers; revising certain licensing fees;  
and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel’s Digest:**

1 Existing law establishes the maximum application and licensing fees the Board  
2 of Examiners for Social Workers may charge. (NRS 641B.300) This bill increases  
3 the maximum amounts that can be charged by the Board.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 641B.300 is hereby amended to read as  
2 follows:

3 641B.300 1. The Board shall charge and collect fees not to  
4 exceed the following amounts for:

7	Provisional license..... <del>[\$75]</del> <i><b>150</b></i>
8	Initial issuance of a license, including a
9	license by endorsement..... <del>[\$100]</del> <i><b>250</b></i>
10	Annual renewal of a license ..... <del>[\$150]</del> <i><b>350</b></i>
11	Restoration of a suspended license or
12	reinstatement of a revoked license ..... <del>[\$150]</del> <i><b>350</b></i>
13	Restoration of an expired license ..... <del>[\$200]</del> <i><b>250</b></i>
14	Renewal of a delinquent license ..... <del>[\$100]</del> <i><b>250</b></i>
15	Reciprocal license without examination..... <del>[\$100]</del> <i><b>200</b></i>



1       2. If an applicant submits an application for a license by  
2 endorsement pursuant to NRS 641B.271, the Board shall charge and  
3 collect not more than the fees specified in subsection 1 for the initial  
4 application for and initial issuance of a license.

5       3. If an applicant submits an application for a license by  
6 endorsement pursuant to NRS 641B.272, the Board shall collect not  
7 more than one-half of the fee set forth in subsection 1 for the initial  
8 issuance of the license.

9       **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2019.
