AN ACT relating to social workers; revising certain licensing fees;  
and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1 Existing law establishes the maximum application and licensing fees the Board  
2 of Examiners for Social Workers may charge. (NRS 641B.300) This bill increases  
3 the maximum amounts that can be charged by the Board.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 641B.300 is hereby amended to read as  
2 follows:

~~—3.]~~ If an applicant submits an application for a license by endorsement pursuant to NRS 641B.272, the Board shall collect not more than one-half of the fee set forth in subsection 1 for the initial issuance of the license.

**Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2019.
